

MapBasic® v12.5.1 released

If you are looking to create MapBasic applications for the 64 bit version of MapInfo Pro you need to get MapBasic 12.5.1 [here](#)

MapBasic® is a complete, BASIC-like programming language used to create custom applications for use with MapInfo Pro®. Use MapBasic to extend geographic functionality, automate repetitive operations, or integrate MapInfo Pro with other applications - quickly and easily.

MapBasic applications compiled with MapBasic 12.5.1 do require MapInfo Pro 12.5.1 as a minimum. But they do not specifically require a 64 bit version of MapInfo Pro.

This means that when the next patch for MapInfo Pro 12.5 32 bit is released, you will be able to run MapBasic applications compiled with MapBasic 12.5.1 in the patched version.

However your MapBasic application should be aware that the 32 bit and the 64 bit are using different user interfaces; the classic menu based and the new ribbon based.
